Terms & Conditions

Aussie Broadband are offering an upgrade from Fibre To The Node or Fibre To The Curb to Fibre To The Premise. Terms and Conditions of this offer include:

- The offer applies to current Fibre To The Node (FTTN) and current Fibre To The Curb (FTTC) addresses that have been identified by NBNCo as being eligible for an upgrade to Fibre To The Premise (FTTP).
- For the new FTTP service to be able to be connected, someone aged over 18 years old must be home at the time of any appointments.
- NBN may determine that extra infrastructure (e.g. trenching and conduit) may be required to complete the installation. If this is the case the cost of that extra infrastructure must be paid by the customer.

Minimum eligible plan for current FTTN addresses

- The minimum service that is eligible for an upgrade is 100Mbps/20Mbps plan for Residential addresses and 100Mbps/40Mbps for business addresses

Minimum eligible plan for current FTTC addresses

- The minimum service that is eligible for an upgrade is 250Mbps/25Mbps plan for Residential addresses and 250Mbps/100Mbps for business addresses
